Gach samhradh eagraíonn Coláiste Sheosaimh cúrsaí Gaeilge i gcoílár Ghaeltacht Chonamara do scoláirí bunscoile agus iarbhunscoile.

Déanaimid freastal ar leith ar dhaltaí bunscoile ar Chúrsa B, a bheidh ar siúl ó 26 Meitheamh go 17 Iúil, agus ar Chúrsa C, 17 Iúil go 7 Lúnasa.

Eagraímid chomh maith cúrsaí coicíse a d'fheilfeadh níos fearr, b'fhéidir, do dhaltaí bunscoile. I mbliana beidh dhá chúrsa coicíse againn, Cúrsa D, ó 26 Meitheamh go 10 Iúil, agus Cúrsa E, ó 17 go 31 Iúil.

Colaiste Sheosaimh is located on the country's west coast in the heart of the Connemara Gaeltacht about 50km west of Galway, beside a calm inlet of Galway bay.

RIALACHA AN CHOLAÍSTE:

College rules will be explained to students at interview and also on the first day, including:

1. Sí an Ghaeilge an teanga labhartha le linn an chúrsa. Ní cheadófar aon Bhéarla.
 2. Each student must be in lodgings by 10.00 pm. and remain there until after breakfast.
 3. Swimming is only allowed under the supervision of a member of the College staff.
 4. Misbehaviour of any kind or bullying will not be accepted.
 5. Company keeping of a serious nature is not allowed.
 6. Smoking or having (electronic) cigarettes or lighters is not allowed.
 7. Students are not allowed to enter public-houses. Consumption or possession of alcohol, drugs, aerosols or sharp objects are prohibited at all times during course.
 8. Mobile phones: The use of mobile phones is not allowed as they interfere with continuity of the spoken Irish. Any student found with a phone in their possession will be reprimanded.
 9. A student may not leave the College during the course without good reason and the permission of An Stiúrthóir.
 10. If parents do not wish us to use images of their child on our website or in our publications, this must be made known to the College, prior to course commencement, in writing.
- Coiste an Choláiste reserves the right to send home students for breach of any of its rules. Fees will not be refunded. In such cases it is the responsibility of parents to arrange the collection of the student within 24 hours of expulsion. If a student leaves a course early, fees are non-refundable.

- Deposits are non-refundable except to students not accepted at interview.
- Balance of fees will only be refunded in cases of certified illness occurring not closer than 10 days to start of course.
- Travel: Students can avail of travel to and from college on private coaches at an additional cost. All students will be notified of arrangements prior to course.

RIAIL NA GAELIGE:
