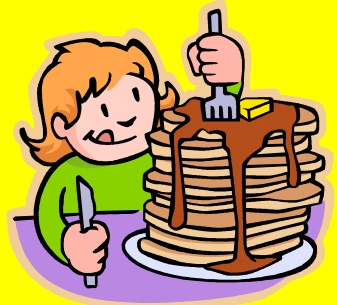
Divided into groups the children each had an important job involving weighing and adding key ingredients. Each ingredient was added with careful precision, down to the last pinch of salt!
