

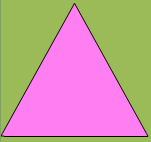
Making Shapes!



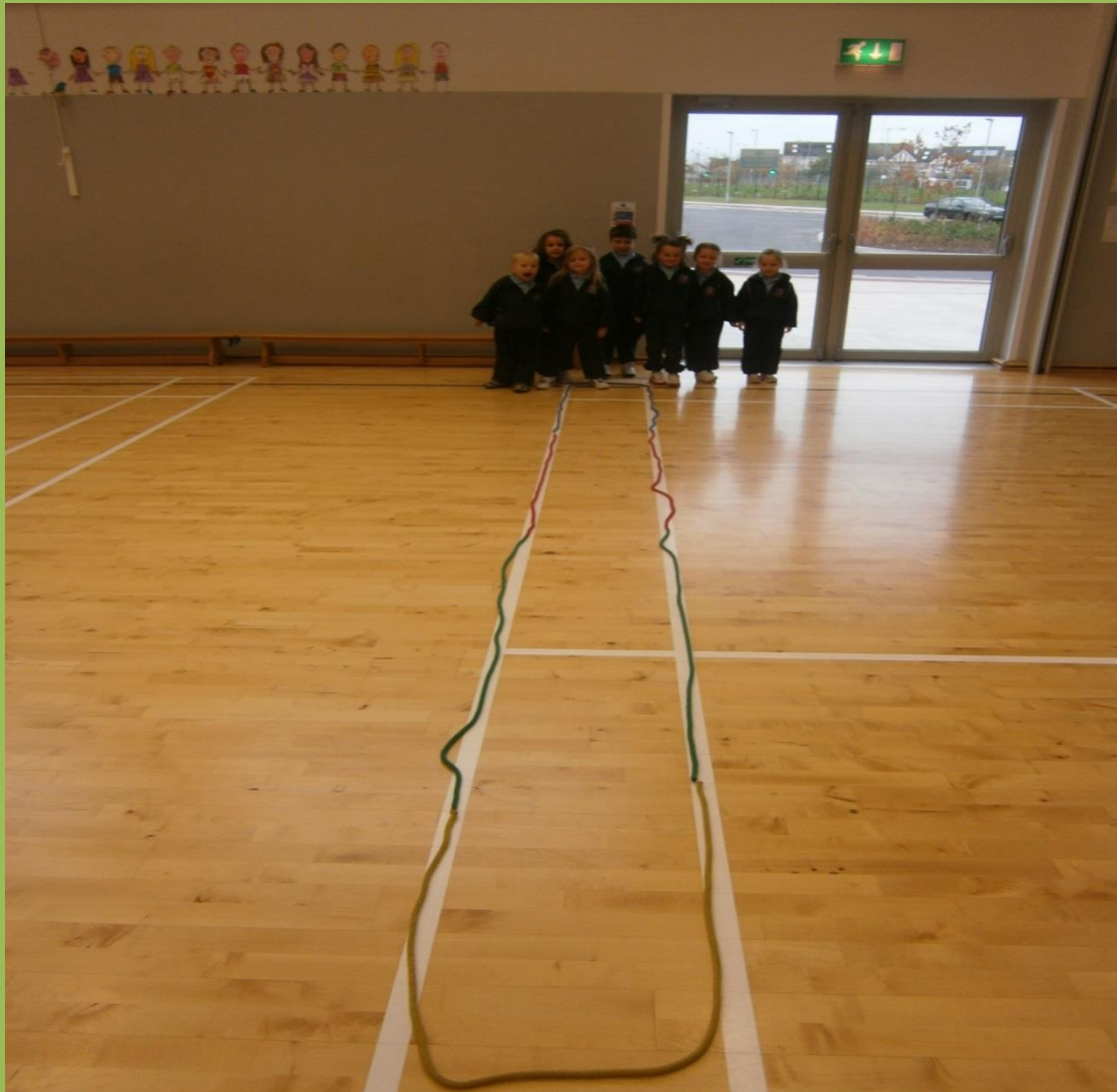

Spectacular circles made by the boys and girls in Ms Talty's class.

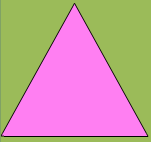


Making Shapes!
